PIPELAYER

Nebraska City Utilities has an opening for a Pipelayer. Under general direction, Install and maintain natural gas mains and services; install and maintain water mains and services; install, clean and maintain sewer mains; investigate gas leaks, respond to customer CO2 calls, re-lite customer pilot lights for natural gas service, identify faulty customer appliances and connections; walk across country leak surveying; monitor natural gas odorant levels; fusion weld polyethylene pipe, repair and rebuild regulators; maintain manholes and barricades; flush fire hydrants; keep account records and maps; maintain trucks, pumps and generators; operate backhoe, mole, jackhammer, air tamps, whacker, directional bore machine, skid loaders, boom truck, grinders, poly welding equipment, locators, tap machine, hand and power tools, trencher, air compressor, tractor, CGI, or other monitor equipment, gas generator, and other equipment as assigned; keep current with all required licensure and certifications; persons in this class may also perform some sewer maintenance tasks, such as: assists in maintenance of sewer lift station, operate jet trucks; perform related work as required. Assist in maintenance at power plant, water plant and waste water treatment plant, such as replacing water lines, pumps, or other projects as assigned. Mows, paints, and reads meter, delivers supplies, pours concrete. May be required to work shift work at one of the plants (water, wastewater, or power plant) and assist electric department with storm damage. Log information on computer or tablet. Basic knowledge of operation and maintenance procedures for natural gas, water and sewer lines; utility equipment; skill in using hand or power tools, operating various trucks, a large variety of equipment (see above); ability to: utilize required knowledge and skills in accomplishment of assigned duties; operate assigned vehicles; keep accurate records; communicate effectively with co-workers, the public and supervisors.

Any combination of training and experience that provides the incumbent with the needed knowledge skills and abilities to perform the required work. Must pass NCU natural gas operator qualification test and **NHHS Grade IV Water Operator License. NCU encourages professional advancement in acquiring a Grade III Water Operator License.** Commercial Driver's License (CDL) required.
